The conference is part of the academic work within the WELLCHI project, which is a Coordination Action under the 6<sup>th</sup> Framework Programme of the European Commission. The purpose of the project is to set up and operate a network to improve the knowledge of the impact of changing family forms, the working conditions of parents and social policy and legislative measures on the well-being of children and their families.

In the framework of the conference a poster session will be organised on each day of the conference. The poster session especially aims to give students and PhDs the opportunity to present their research which is related to the main subjects of the conference:

- Family law
- Child poverty
- Family change
- Immigration and Ethnicity
- Social policy
- Arrangement of work and family
- Social exclusion

Young researchers are invited to send a proposal for a poster session with an abstract of no more than 500 words describing the contents of their proposal. The deadline for the application is **December 31<sup>st</sup> 2006**. A limited number of contributors can receive financial support for travel costs up to 400€. Applications for funding of travel costs can be submitted together with the proposal for poster session.
